- 1. All entries for this division will be subject to the General Livestock Rules of the Galveston County Fair & Rodeo, Inc. except where they conflict with the requirements of this division in which case the division rules will prevail. In the event of special circumstances that may arise, or a conflict between rules, decisions of the Show Chairperson and the Livestock Superintendent will be final.
- 2. All lambs will be tagged-in, nose printed, and toothed on Saturday, December 05, 2020 from 9:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. at the Fairgrounds. Lambs will be toothed on date of tag-in. Lambs must have both central temporary incisors in place with no permanent incisors showing when toothed.
- 3. Lambs must weigh not less than 100 pounds at check-in, Saturday, April 17, 2021. All Market Lamb will be weighed by the exhibitor on the designated scales provided by the Lamb Committee. Each exhibitor must return the weight card to the official check-in table no later than 11:30 am on Saturday, April 17, 2021. The weight card is the INDIVIDUAL OFFICIAL WEIGHT. Once the weight card is turned in, absolutely no changes can be made. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 4. Each exhibitor is entitled to enter and show two (2) lambs in the 2021 Galveston County Fair, either ewe or wether lamb. Entries must be submitted online by January 21, 2021. Further instructions will be sent to your 4-H Leader/Ag Teacher when these forms become available. All Exhibitors will turn in the entry fees to the 4-H Leader/Ag Teacher of the club/chapter they will be exhibiting under.
- 5. Bedding (shavings) will be allowed in lamb pens at exhibitor's expense. Exhibitor's shavings cannot be stored on the fairgrounds.
- 6. Absolutely no tying of lambs allowed in pens. Lambs must remain in assigned pens unless authorized by the Lamb Chairperson or Livestock Superintendent to be moved to a different pen.
- 7. No paint or colored powders are allowed. "BLOW DRYERS" WILL BE ALLOWED TO BE USED ONLY AT THE POWER PLANT.
- 8. All lambs MUST be shorn 3/8" or less PRIOR TO ARRIVAL on Galveston County Fair & Rodeo, Inc. Grounds. NO CLIPPING OR TOUCH UPS AFTER ARRIVAL WITH ANY (ELECTRICAL OR MANUAL, SCISSORS, RAZORS, KNIFE, ETC.) APPLIANCES.
- 9. Exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their lamb and keeping the stall and lamb barn area clean at all times. There will be **NO FEEDING OR WATERING IN THE LAMB PENS**.
